



LEAD ACCIDENT INVESTIGATION

An IOSH approved qualification for anyone with responsibility for leading or conducting investigations into personal injury or accidents in the workplace.

The workshop is delivered online, in a virtual classroom environment. On successful completion the delegates will be more confident and competent to analyse accidents, incidents, near-misses, equipment failures and operating issues in their own workplace. Delegates will uncover root causes that may previously have been overlooked and provide stronger and more robust corrective actions.

Duration: 3 days

On successful completion of the course delegates will:

- Understand the moral, legal and financial reasons for reporting and investigating accidents in the workplace
- Know the law with regard to managing safely, RIDDOR, employers' and employees' duties and responsibilities
- Recognise best practice in the accident investigation process, including elements of preparation, emergency response, evidence collection and analysis, report writing and making recommendations to improve safety
- Know how to work safely and efficiently at an accident site
- Be competent in conducting witness interviews and collecting material evidence from a variety of relevant sources
- Be able to analyse evidence to develop a no-blame report of what occurred
- Have a clearly defined strategy for recommending changes for future accident prevention

The course includes:

- Case studies and scenarios
- Preparing and conducting witness interviews
- Group analysis of evidence from a variety of sources
- Example reports
- Best practice in recommending change for future prevention
- RIDDOR and relevant Health and Safety Law
- On Day 3 there is an online assessment
